## Objective

The Titans Junior Club Challenge is an event open to Junior Club teams from across Queensland, providing opportunities for Coaches, players and referees to develop through participation in the sport under tournament conditions.

## Section 2: Entry Information

### 2.1 Divisions

U10 Boys	U10 Girls
U12 Boys	U12 Girls
U14 Boys	U14 Girls
U16 Boys	U16 Girls

The minimum age for U10 Divisions is 8 years as of 1 January 2018

### 2.2 Team Eligibility

Nominations are open to individual or Club teams, who meet these requirements:

2.2.1 teams must be competing in a Season 1 or Season 2 TFA affiliated competition.

2.2.2 Affiliates that have a junior competition with less than 30 teams in total may:

- i. Nominate as a club or team from that competition or
- ii. Nominate as an affiliate team with players from that competition

2.2.3 Teams must be fully financial at all levels of affiliation

### 2.3 Player Eligibility

2.3.1 Players can only play in the age division that they participate in their local competition.

2.3.2 Players can only play in one division

2.3.3 Be fully financial at all levels of affiliation

2.3.4 Be registered members of the Club they are playing for

The Titans Junior Club Challenge Nomination Fee is **\$25 per player**, which is to be paid online at the time of registration. Please note: Players who withdraw from the competition after payment will be refunded \$24.25 (due to SportsTG payment levy) and are subject to the condition regarding dates set out below.

Refunds: Any team that withdraws will be in consideration for a refund of registration. Withdrawal must be via written correspondence to SWQ Touch by Monday 12 November. Teams withdrawing after 12 November will forfeit 50% of each player's nomination

## 2.5 Venue

## 2.6 Coordinators and Team Management

Team Management personnel must be members and registered within the Club they represent, in the current or previous competition.

All Managers, Coaching and support staff must hold a Qld Blue card and be linked with their affiliated Club.

## 2.7 Club Coaches

Desirable Coach accreditation – TFA Foundation Coach

Responsibilities of nomination as a Coach:

- Complete the individual Coach's registration by 16 November, 2018
- hold a Qld Blue card and be linked with respective Club
- Once registered online, coaches are eligible to nominate for mentoring

## 2.8 Referee Nomination

Referee participation in this event is voluntary.

Teams are required to nominate a minimum of one (1) referee per team. The referee nomination must be completed as part of the team nomination process.



#### Referee Responsibilities of Nomination:

- Be available for the duration of the competition, teams who fail to comply may lose the right to play in finals
- Complete the individual referee's registration by 16 November, 2018
- Once registered online, referees are eligible to nominate for referee coaching

If the referee nomination is not completed team nominations may be rejected.

## 2.9 Team Numbers

U10 teams must register a minimum of eight (8) players, U12 to U16 teams must register a minimum of eleven (11) players and a maximum of fourteen (14) players for the event. Upon protest, any team found either using more than fourteen (14) players or using an unregistered player may be liable to be disqualified. NB A player may only register in 1 team.

## 2.10 Communication

All correspondence and dealings must be made through the Team Manager. All communication with Clubs and Teams will be through the email address and mobile number provided.

It is the responsibility of the Coaches and Managers to ensure players and parents are informed of any changes when notified by SWQ and that they are conversant with these Conditions of Entry and the General Conditions of Entry.

## 2.11 Team Management Briefing

## Section 3: Event Operations

### 3.1 Control of the Event

SWQ Touch will be in charge of all matters relating to the Tournament.

### 3.2 Weather

In the case of weather impacting this event SWQ will utilise the powers set out in of the SWQ Tournament General Conditions. If any change shall occur each team will be emailed and information will also be placed on the SWQ website, Facebook page and Instagram account.

### 3.3 Match Results

Match results will be updated on the SWQ Touch Football Team App and website at the completion of each competition round.

### 3.4 Competition Points

For all divisions the following applies:

Win - 3 points	Draw - 2 points	Loss - 1 point	Forfeit - 0 points	Bye - 0 points
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Forfeited games 5-0 (3 Points for the win no bonus points allocated to forfeited games.)

### 3.5 Club Championship Points

Division Winners	50 Points
Division Runners Up	30 Points
Division Semi Finalists	20 Points
Division Quarter Finalists	10 Points

Only one (1) Team per division from the same Club will be eligible to earn points in the Club Championship. Whichever of the two entries finishes higher will be considered for Club Championship Points.

### 3.6 Game duration

Game duration will be subject to team nominations in the competition.

### 3.7 Draw Format

The format will be decided when all team nominations have been received.



### 3.8 Medical

First Aid will be available on the day for the treatment of minor injuries sustained at this tournament, not for strapping of injuries, pre-existing conditions or rub-downs. An ambulance will be called for more serious injuries

### 3.9 Movement of Players between Divisions

In this competition players are unable to move between divisions nor change teams within any Club.

### 3.10 Finals Eligibility

A player must have played a minimum of one (1) round game to be eligible for the final series. Any players not able to fulfil the criteria due to extenuating circumstances must make written application to [admin@swqtouch.com](mailto:admin@swqtouch.com) for consideration, prior to the Tournament commencement.

### 3.11 Team Registration Forms

Are to be printed by the Club Coordinator, signed by the team official and lodged with tournament control prior to the first game.

### 3.12 Rules

SWQ tournaments will be conducted under TFA rules as specified in the Touch Football Australia 7th Edition rule book.

### 3.13 Send Offs

Any player sent from the field for the remainder of the game will receive an automatic two (2) match suspension unless the Disciplinary Committee considers further action. Any player who receives two "periods of time" throughout the tournament (not in the same game), will also receive an Automatic one (1) match suspension. Every subsequent period of time will receive an automatic one (1) match suspension
